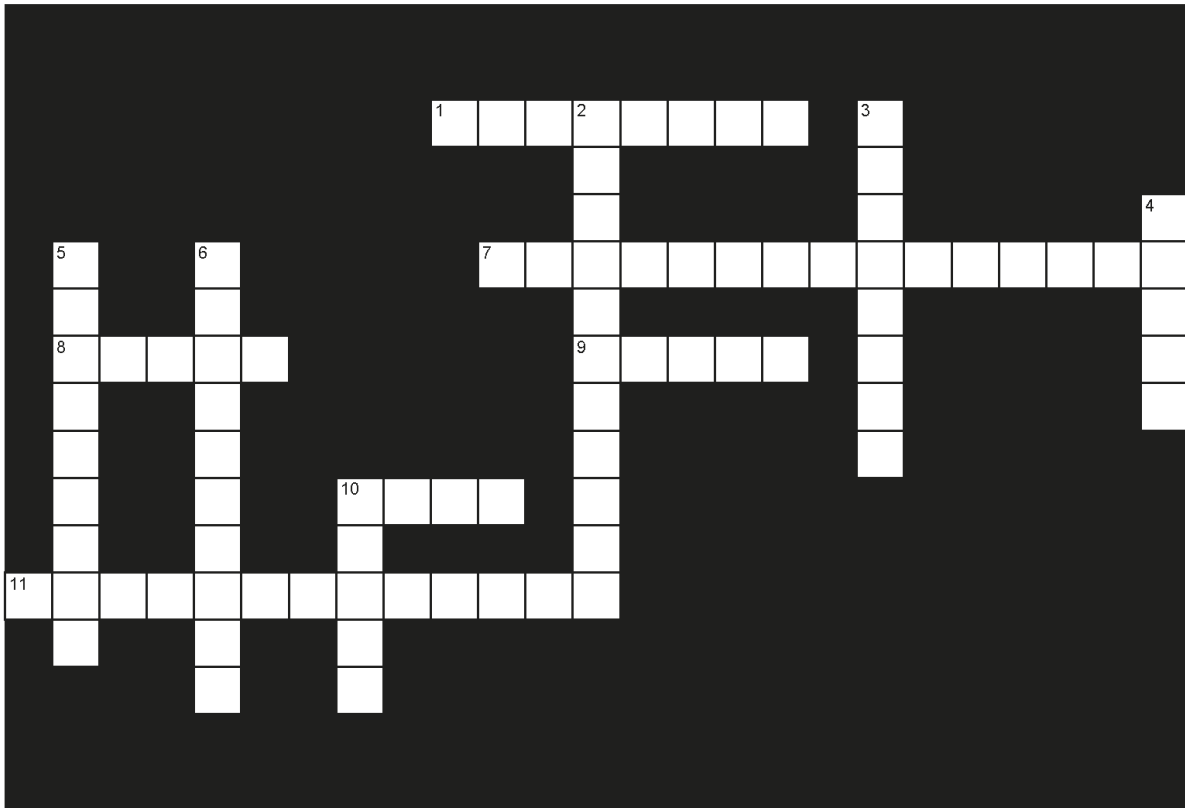


Digestive Systems of Livestock: A Basic Look
