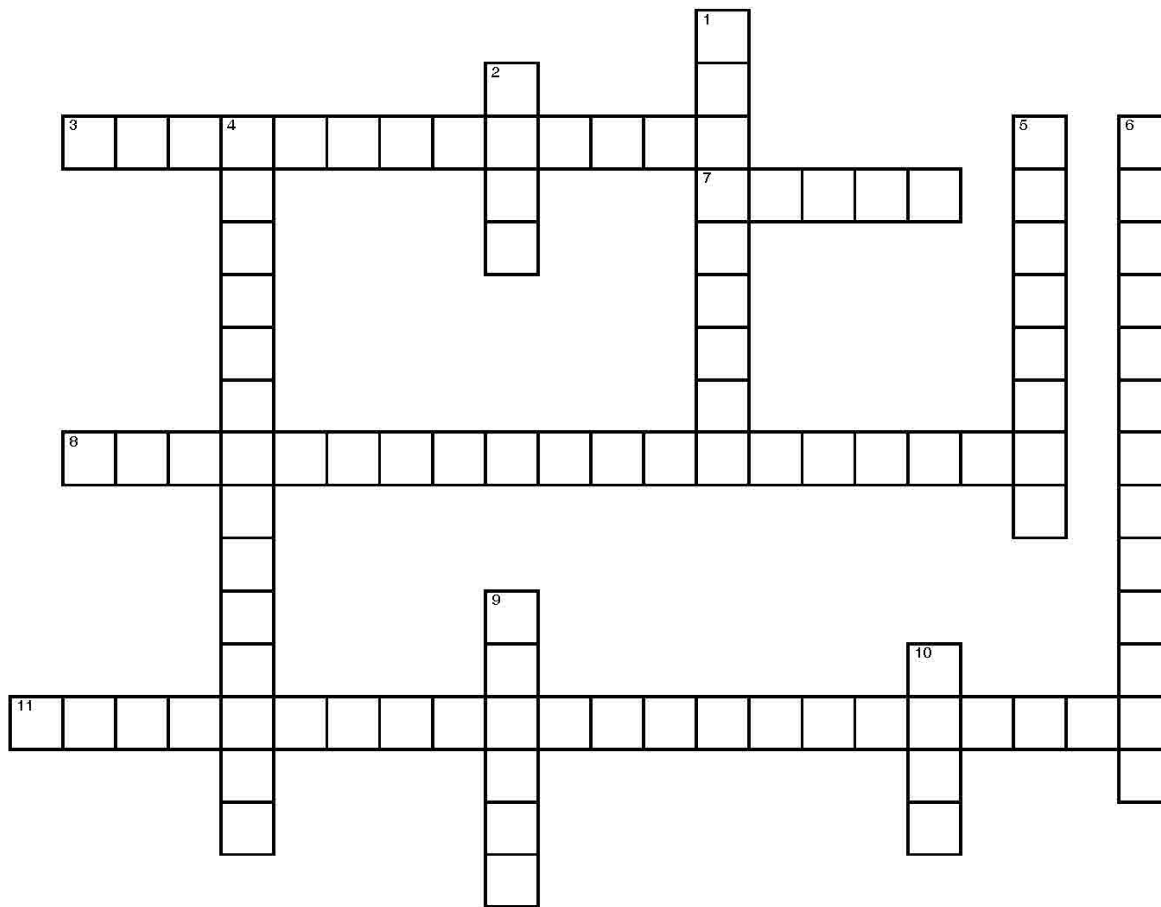

1. process of converting animal tissue into value-added material
2. white, solid or semisolid fat rendered from pork carcasses

6. act of breeding different breeds of the same species together to form a hybrid breed
9. fat rendered from beef carcasses used to make products such as soap and lubricants
